### God speaking through dreams

Throughout Scripture, dreams are shown as one of the ways God communicates with His people. Dreams are not always ordinary pictures of the night; sometimes they carry spiritual meaning, direction, warning, or encouragement. There are many occasions in the Bible where God used dreams to reveal His plans. Job 33:14-15 says, "For God speaketh once, yea twice, yet man perceiveth it not. In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men." This reminds us that even when people are not paying attention during the day, God continues to speak in the quietness of sleep. Dreams therefore should never be ignored, because they may contain a message from the Lord.

Many people today dismiss dreams as imagination, stress, or random thoughts. While not every dream is spiritual, believers should remain sensitive because some dreams can be divine. In the Bible, Joseph had dreams that revealed his future-(Genesis 37:5-9). The dreams outlined his Godly purpose. Later, Pharaoh's dreams revealed coming famine, and through interpretation many lives were saved (Genesis 41:25-32). In the New Testament, Joseph the husband of Mary was warned in a dream to flee to Egypt to protect Jesus (Matthew 2:13). These examples show what dreams can bring; foretelling, guidance, protection, and revelation. When we neglect them, we may miss what God is saying.

The Word of God teaches that dreams are connected to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Joel 2:28 declares, "Your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions." This was repeated in Acts 2:17 when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the church. As long as we dream, we are experiencing part of the gifts and manifestations of the Spirit, showing that God still speaks today. It is prudent for us to receive them with humility, test-them against Scripture, and bring them before God in prayer.

When a believer has a dream, the first response must be prayer. Instead of fear or confusion, we should ask God for understanding and/or revelation. Daniel prayed for revelation, and God revealed hidden mysteries to him (Daniel 2:19). As understanding dreams requires great depth of wisdom, James 1:5 guides appropriately; "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God." Prayer yields discernment whether a dream is from God and how to respond. Discernment is essential to distinguish the dreams on the revelations they carry; spiritual battles, warnings, or promises, and teach us how to specifically pray upon each dream.

Dreams are a reminder that God still desires to speak personally to His children. They should never replace the Bible, but they can confirm what God is already saying through His Word. Believers should pay attention, write them down, and pray upon them. In a generation that often ignores dreams or have alternative explanations of dreams, the church must return to recognizing that God still speaks, and His voice through dreams has drawn His people closer to Him.

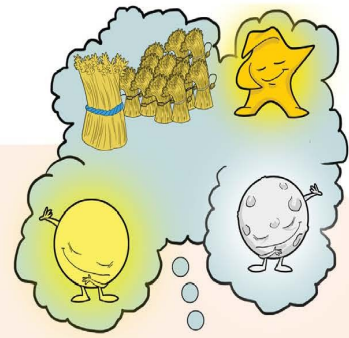
